

## KEY TO OLD FAMILY PHOTOGRAPHS:

### FAMILY PICTURE

Taken on the afternoon of Grace and Phil's Wedding, September 18, 1934, in Cole's backyard, 143 Springfield Avenue, Rutherford, NJ. Note Hinkelman's house in background. Little girl named Jane Hinkelman McGarry told Phil she remembered looking out the window when picture was being taken. Mass was at 10:00 AM at St. Mary RC Church, followed by a reception (where?). Grace and Phil had already departed on their honeymoon. Identification per Philip A. Schneider, May 2000.

- Uriah Joseph Cole (Grace's father)
- Margaret O'Shaughnessy (wife of Tommy Morris)—they had 5 children; Margaret died young and left Tom with the children. Tom was very capable sports writer. Tom was unable to cope with child rearing—alcohol problem—kids were dispersed (“farmed out”) to relatives. Margaret was the same age as Phil and they attended Ohio State University together. Margaret was Campus Queen and Phil took her to the Ball.
- (Phil's Aunt) Kitty Schneider (nee Brroune?—from Belfast, Ireland). Married to Uncle Frank (who had the boat—was very successful in business and lived long—was probably an alcoholic). Aunt Kitty developed psychiatric problems, died in an institution. One story is that she jumped or fell out of a window.
- Ann Schneider (Phil's sister, sitting on chair, barely visible)
- Jerry Schneider
